

Care and cleaning guidelines for JUNG surfaces – Version for end customers

Introduction Design and service life

The high-quality surfaces of the JUNG design covers are intended for daily use and a long service life. Specially selected materials, highly-advanced lacquers and premium surface decorations form the basis of our top quality products. As a result our surfaces are easy to clean and at the same time resistant to many everyday and environmental influences. The suitability of our products and surfaces for daily use and their service life is proven in advance in countless laboratory tests.

General recommendations for cleaning

We recommend using a soft, lint-free and slightly damp cloth to clean all JUNG surfaces. Make sure you use clean cloths, as particles of sand or dust could leave unwanted marks on the surfaces. Do not excessively or vigorously rub the surfaces with any cloths. The use of extra cleaning agents is not necessary. If you would still like to use a cleaning agent, we recommend that you sparingly use a standard washing-up liquid, ph-neutral cleaning agent or similar. This recommendation also applies to all JUNG surfaces, except for surfaces in Le Corbusier colours – with these colours please refer to the special notes below!

In general, you should not use aggressive cleaning agents such as:

- Abrasive cleaning agents
- Acidic cleaning agents (e.g. vinegar-based cleaners or vinegar essence, citric acid)
- Strong alkaline cleaning agents
- Oxidising solutions (e.g. chlorine cleaning agents, hydrogen peroxide solution)
- Aromatic solvents (e.g. acetone, nail polish remover, thinners)
- Benzine
- Alcohol (e.g. methylated spirits)

In general, it is not recommended to drip-dry clean our products as in this case moisture may get into the area of the electrical contacts. Therefore, sprays and spray cleaners should also not be applied directly to the surface.

Do not use coarse cotton or linen cloths, scouring pads, cleaning erasers made of melamine (also called “magic erasers”) or other abrasive cleaning utensils, as they could damage the surface.

We recommend using a soft, lint-free and damp cloth with pure water or alcohol (ethanol, methylated spirits) to clean surfaces in Le Corbusier colours. Do not use any other cleaning agents.

SILVERPLUS surfaces should be cleaned regularly to ensure optimal functioning of antimicrobial properties. The use of alcoholic disinfectants is also possible.
